It is indeed disheartening to know that 90 % of the people in the waiting list die before they get an organ donor. The thought is simple. What if one of the persons on the waiting was a relative, friend or a loved one? Becoming an organ or tissue donor is literally a decision to save the lives of others. Those 'others' may be family members, friends, neighbors or co-workers. One organ donor can touch more than 50 lives. The effort aims to increase awareness for registering as a donor with a simple change on a driver's license, state ID card, or by going online.



The gathering at Sushila Devi Auditorium at SAI International School took the movement of "Donating Life" with all sincerity and pledged to debunk the myths surrounding it.
